

DELETING HISTORY IN COMMON BROWSERS

1) Microsoft Edge

- ✓ Select **Settings and more > Settings > Privacy and services**.
- ✓ Under **Clear browsing data**, select **Choose what to clear**.
- ✓ Choose a time range from the **Time range** drop-down menu.
- ✓ Choose the types of data you want to clear. For example, you may want to remove browsing history and cookies but keep passwords and autofill form data.
- ✓ Select **Clear now**.

You can automatically clear your browsing data when you close the browser. Select **Choose what to clear every time you close the browser** and choose which types of data should be cleared.

2) Google Chrome

Delete all your browsing history

- ✓ At the top right of your browser, click on “more” or “settings” (depending on the version of your browser)
- ✓ Click **History > History**.
- ✓ On the left, click **clear browsing data**. A box will appear.
- ✓ In the box that appears, select from the drop-down menu how much history you want to delete. To clear everything, select **the beginning of time**.
- ✓ Check the boxes for the info you want Chrome to clear. In any case, select “**browsing history**.”
- ✓ Click **Clear browsing data**.

Delete specific pages from your browsing history

You can also delete certain parts of your history. To search for something specific, use the search bar at the top.

- ✓ Check the box next to each item that you want to remove from your History.
- ✓ At the top right, click **Delete**.
- ✓ Confirm by clicking **Remove**.

3) Safari

- ✓ Click on **History** in the top bar of your browser
- ✓ Click the pop-up menu
- ✓ Choose how far back you want your browsing history cleared.

4) Mozilla Firefox

- ✓ Click the menu button
- ✓ Choose **History**, and then **Clear Recent History**
- ✓ Click the drop-down menu next to **Time range to clear** to choose how much of your history Firefox will clear.
- ✓ Next, click the arrow next to **Details** to select exactly what information will get cleared.
- ✓ Finally, click the **Clear Now** button.
